What the Grasshopper Uses Buttons For

The grasshopper uses buttons for all sorts of things. They make nice decorations hanging on the walls of grasshopper houses. Grasshoppers also use buttons for plates to eat their meals. And nearly every Wednesday, grasshoppers get together to play flying disc with them. Sometimes they tie strings through the holes and wear buttons as hats for a bit of shade. Cotton balls on buttons make nice beds for the grasshoppers' overnight guests like ladybugs and roly-polys. Grasshoppers also use buttons to compete in button spinning (similar to plate spinning) at the Summer Grasshopper Fair, and buttons are necessary when building grasshopper racers to compete in the Grasshopper Drag Races. All of the grasshoppers entered in the races use buttons for wheels, seats, and steering wheels.
